

Acceptable Use Policy

Compliance with U.S. Laws. If you are using our Services in the United States you agree that:

You shall comply with and provide any notices and obtain any consent required under the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act and the U.S. Department of Education's implementing regulations at 34 CFR Part 99 (collectively, "FERPA"), the Children's Online Privacy Protection Act of 1998, as amended ("COPPA") and all other applicable laws, rules or regulations concerning the collection, use, and disclosure of personally identifiable information about Users (collectively, "Applicable Privacy Law"), including reviewing disclosures regarding use of the Services, our Terms, and our Privacy Policy, and providing any consent required from Parents to extent required under COPPA FERPA, or other Applicable Privacy Law.

1. PROHIBITION ON SHARING CONTENT

You are prohibited from using our Services to share content that:

- a. uses any portion of the Services, website, or access to the Services or website, to reproduce, duplicate, copy sell, resell or otherwise exploit, for any commercial use or purpose unless expressly permitted by Brain Builder in writing, it being understood that the Services and related services are intended for personal, non-commercial use only;
- b. except as expressly permitted by these Terms, rent, lease, loan, sell, resell, sublicense, distribute or otherwise transfer the licenses for any Services Materials;

cause harm, or otherwise inappropriate; Please remember that our users can be under the age of 13.

e. uses the Services in any manner that is harmful to minors or in any manner that violates Brain Builder's Terms of Use;

f. impersonates any person or entity, falsely claim an affiliation with any person or entity, or access the Services accounts of others without permission, create accounts via bots or other automated means, mislead any person regarding whether Output generated by or through use of the Services is human-generated, or perform any other fraudulent activity;

g. uses the Services to commit any act of educational or academic dishonesty;

h. develops, supports or uses software, devices, scripts, robots, or any other means or processes (including crawlers, browser plugins and add-ons, or any other technology) to scrape the Services or otherwise copy lessons or other data from the Services;

i. uses the Services or the website, or any content, data, output, or other information received, derived, or otherwise harvested therefrom, to develop, create, train, fine-tune, test, align, or otherwise improve any machine learning algorithms or artificial intelligence models, whether directly or indirectly and whether for yourself or a third party;

j. asserts, or authorizes, assists, or encourage any third party to assert, against Brain Builder or any of its affiliates or licensors any patent infringement or other intellectual property infringement claim regarding any Licensed Educational Content, Licensed Educational Code, or User Content you have used, submitted, or otherwise made available on or through the Services;

k. makes unsolicited offers, advertisements, proposals, or send junk mail or spam to other Users of the Services (including, but not limited to, unsolicited advertising, promotional materials, political campaign materials, or other solicitation material, bulk mailing of commercial advertising, chain mail, informational announcements, charity requests, and petitions for signatures);

- r. otherwise interferes with or violates the Services Agreement, Privacy Policy, Refund and Payment Policy, or copyright policy of Brain Builders.

- b. Notification of parents or guardians (if applicable).
- c. Legal action in severe cases.
